

CUSTOMER STABS TWO GUARDS AT BROKERS' OFFICE

A disgruntled customer turned yesterday upon two special policemen and stabbed them with a penknife after they had taken him from the Logan & Bryan brokerage office on the fourth floor of a building at 105 West Adams street. They were taken to the Iroquois hospital, where it was found that neither was seriously wounded. Their assailant, T. J. Brownley, who is believed to be 70 years old, escaped. His address was unknown to the brokerage office. Brownley, according to the story told police, had lost between \$500 and \$600 in the stock market about five years ago and has since blamed employees of the firm for his loss.
